Price- it is significantly less expensive than reclaimed heart pine. It should run somewhere between 1/4 to 1/3 the cost of reclaimed 2. Availability- Reclaimed can take weeks or months to get. From the dealers perspective, there are few if any reliable, regular suppliers of heart pine. We now have it available out of our warehouses and we can ship special orders with a week to ten day turnaround. 3. Consistency of grade- Bennetts Creek being the best grade followed by Merchants Millpond. Each grade contains at least 70% heart

<p>What is New Heart Pine?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut from Loblolly pine trees that are generally between 100 and 150 years old • It is cut from the center or heart of the tree • The color will change from a yellow to a more pink/red color with exposure to light and air 	<p>What New Heart Pine isn't:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It is <u>not</u> cut from long leaf pine trees- all of the following were cut from long leaf pine trees <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ It is <u>not</u> antique heart pine ◦ It is <u>not</u> reclaimed heart pine ◦ It is <u>not</u> river recovered heart pine ◦ It is <u>not</u> "old growth" heart pine 														
<p>U.S. Lumber New Heart Pine</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Varying amounts of heartwood vs. sapwood even when cut from center • The higher the resin content of the heart, the harder the wood is and the more likely to change color • Sapwood has less resin content and is softer and less durable • Variable knot size and frequency • Generally fewer growth rings per inch verses Antique Heart pine 	<p>Antique Heart Pine</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High resin content causes redness and hardness • Knots generally infrequent and small • Growth rings are tighter, 200 plus year old trees with high number of growth rings/inch • Hardness compares to red oak
